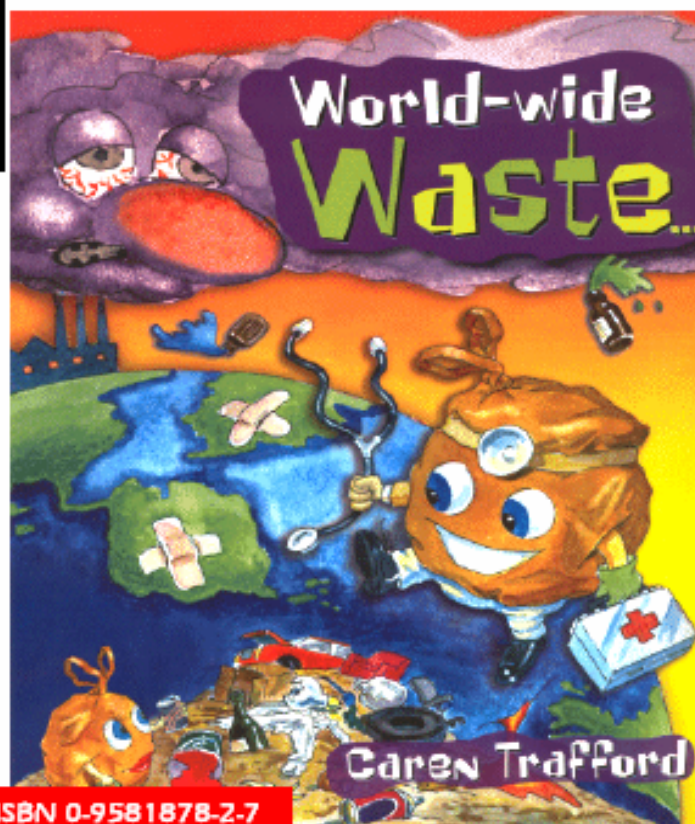




# World - wide Waste...
